## Summary

Provide a brief, non-confidential **summary** of your **idea** clearly describing the **challenge/problem** and your **solution**. Describe what is **unconventional** about your approach, why you expect it to **succeed** and how it will deliver **impact**. How will the work you describe be performed within the **budget and timeline**?

[Max. 200 words]

## Team

Provide a clear description on **how, through its composition, complementarity and formation**, the team brings a **unique perspective** in addressing this problem. Applicants are strongly advised **not to provide biographies** of team members but rather to convey the team's ambition and its ability to deliver.

## Challenge

Describe clearly the specific challenge/**problem** that will be addressed, articulate their **understanding of it** and **identify key issues or barriers** in addressing this problem....

....include any insights from engaging with stakeholders/beneficiaries and how these **validate the problem**.

## Solution

Clearly describe the proposed **solution**, of how it is **novel** and how technological development enables this solution. Describe the current **state-of-the-art** and how the proposed approach will **overcome current barriers**. Evidence that the solution is **feasible**/viable and associated risks should be provided.



- Track record in x area but not in y area
- Problem – not fully understood
- State of the art not contextualised
- Novelty, originality, methodology not well described
- Scope – too broad
- Budget – Inadequate detail, poor justification
- Team size, membership, track record, budget
- Letters of support - missing/additional
- Metrics





- Generation of knowledge
- Development of individuals
- Contribution to research community
- Contribution to broader society
